Applications with Photo uploaded are invited On-line only from qualified candidates belonging to Physically Handicapped (Deaf) category in the State of Kerala for selection to the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service.

- 1 Department : Public Works/Irrigation
- 2 Name of post : III Grade Overseer/Tracer
- 3 Scale of pay : ₹ 9940-16580
- 4 Number of vacancies : Deaf - 5 (Five)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The ranked list published for P.H.(Deaf) candidates only as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to Physically Handicapped (Deaf) persons but remains unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked list published for the post on 01.12.2008 (Gazette date 27.12.2005, Category No.219/2005)

- 5 Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from among the candidates belonging to Physically Handicapped (Deaf) persons). Applications submitted by the candidates who do not belong to Physically Handicapped (Deaf) persons will be rejected. Such candidates will not be given separate rejection memo.
6. Age : 18-35. Only candidates born between 02.01.1976 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post.

General conditions]

- 7 Qualifications:
 - (i) Pass in S.S.L.C. Examination or its equivalent qualification, and
 - (ii) Must possess any one of the qualifications mentioned below:
 - (a) Lower Grade Drawing Group Certificate KGTE or equivalent.
 - (b) Second Grade Certificate secured by Draftsman (Civil) Trainees under T.T.Scheme, College of Engineering or under Industrial Training Centre conducted by the Ministry of Labour, Govt. of India, after a course of 18 months.
 - (c) Building Drawing and Estimating (Higher or Lower) KGTE or equivalent and any two of the other Civil Engineering Subjects under KGTE or equivalent.

(d) Diploma in Civil Engineering (2 years course) of the Women's Polytechnics of the State.

(e) Diploma in Agricultural and Rural Engineering given by the Rural Institute, Thavanur.

(f) Vocational Higher Secondary Course Certificate in Draftsmanship and Quantity Surveying,

(g) Vocational Higher Secondary Course Certificate in Building Technology.

8. Mode of submitting applications :-

The applications shall be submitted on-line only. For details regarding the submission of applications log on to www.keralapsc.org . A recent passport size photograph should be uploaded with application. Photographs uploaded should be of colour/black & white taken within six months. The name of the candidate and the date of taking photographs should be printed at the bottom.

Other conditions related to uploading of photographs

- 1) Photographs uploaded should be colour/black & white and the face and the upper parts of the shoulders be clear.
- 2) Uploading photographs should be 200 pixels height, 150 pixels width not exceeding a file size of 30 kb in jpg format.
- 3) The back ground of the photographs should be white/light coloured.
- 4) The face should be centrally focussed.
- 5) The eyes should be open and vivid.
- 6) It should be without cap or goggles.

No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in to all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Application which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

9. Last date for receipt of Applications : 30.11.2011 Wednesday upto 12 Midnight.

11. If a written Test/OMR Test is conducted as part of the Selection, Hall Ticket of eligible Candidates will be made available in the website of the Kerala public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Hall Ticket as per the instructions in the website.

At the time of Examination, Physical Efficiency Test, Practical Test, Interview etc, Candidates shall produce their Photo affixed ID proof in Original and self attested photocopy of (Voters Identity Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare Department to Physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed Pass Books issued by Nationalized Banks, PAN Card, Identity Cards issued to Government Employees by the concerned Departments) along with Hall Tickets.
