**Fourth NCA Notification**

Applications with photo uploaded are invited online only from qualified candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes communities in the State of Kerala for the following post.

1. Department : Kerala Collegiate Education
2. Name of post : Lecturer in Sanskrit (general)
3. Scale of pay : U.G.C
4. Number of vacancies : 382/1011 - SC-2  
383/2011 - ST-1

The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes but remains unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked list published on 26-12-2006 for the post. This is the fourth NCA notification for the post owing to non availability of qualified candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe communities as per the first NCA Notification (gazette Date 30-4-2007 category No.154/07 Second NCA Notification (Gazette Date. 13-8-2008 category No.291/08) and Third NCA Notification (Gazette Date. 31-12-2009 category No. 499/09)

5. Method of Appointment - Direct Recruitment - (From candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes only of Kerala state) Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes communities will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them. But in the absence of scheduled Castes candidates scheduled Tribe candidates and in the absence of scheduled Tribe candidates scheduled Castes candidates will be considered.

6. Age - 22 – 45 only candidates born between 2-1-1966 and 1-1-1989 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post (Including the relaxation in para 2 (1) of general conditions)

(For conditions regarding other age relaxations please see para (2) of the general conditions except para 2(1).

## 7. Qualifications

(1) Masters Degree in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks or its equivalent and good academic record.

(2) Must have passed a Comprehensive Test in the concerned subject specifically conducted for the purpose by UGC or any agency duly constituted by the state government in this behalf. When qualifications are being equal preference shall be given to candidates who possess adequate knowledge in Malayalam.

Note (i) Candidates who have obtained Ph.D Degree in the concerned subject or have passed M.Phil Degree in the concerned subject by 31-12-1993 are exempted from passing the NET examination (G.O(P) No:123/02/H.Edn dated 17-9-2002) (G.O. (MS) No:86/07/H.Edn dated 19-6-2007)

(ii) For recruitment to various posts under these rules Degree awarded by the Universities recognized by UGC alone shall be considered.

## 8. Method of submitting applications:-

The Applications with photo uploaded shall be submitted by online only. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz [WWW.keralapsc.org](http://WWW.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondences.

Documents to prove qualification, age and community in original have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

9. Last date of receipt of applications : 30.11.2011 Wednesday upto 12 midnight.

11. If a written Test/OMR Test is conducted as part of the Selection, Hall Ticket of eligible Candidates will be made available in the website of the Kerala public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Hall Ticket as per the instructions in the website.

At the time of Examination, Physical Efficiency Test, Practical Test, Interview etc, Candidates shall produce their Photo affixed ID proof in Original and self attested photocopy of (Voters Identity Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare Department to Physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed Pass Books issued by Nationalized Banks, PAN Card, Identity Cards issued to Government Employees by the concerned Departments) along with Hall Tickets.
