THIRD NCA NOTIFICATION

DIRECT RECRUITMENT FOR MUSLIM RESERVATION COMMUNITIES

Applications with photo uploaded are invited Online only from qualified candidates of Muslim community in Kerala for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service . This is the Third NCA notification due to the non-availability of candidates belonging to the Muslim community for the under mentioned post notified as per Category No.132/2009 published in the Gazette dated 30.04.2009 and Category No.197/2010 published in the Gazetted dated 15.07.2010.

- 1 Department** : Kerala Port Department (Hydrographic Survey Branch)
- 2 Name of post** : Assistant Marine Surveyor
- 3 Scale of Pay** : ₹ 20740-36140/-
- 4 Number of vacancy** : Muslim -1 (One)

The ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until Candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for Muslim Community but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked list published on 29.12.2005 for the post.

- 5 Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment (from among candidates of Muslim community only).

Note:- The applications submitted by candidates other than Muslim community will be rejected.

Individual communication regarding the rejection of their application will not be issued.

- 6 Age limit** : Age 18-38. Only candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the Post . (Including relaxations in Para 2 (i) of the General Conditions)

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 except 2(i) of part II General

7. **Qualifications:-**

1. A pass in S.S.L.C or it's equivalent Examination
2. Must possess Survey Recorder class I or II qualification of the Indian Naval Hydrographic Branch.

Note:-

- (1) Candidates possessing Survey Recorder Class I qualification must have an experience of not less than 4 years in Hydrographic Survey from the date of acquiring the Survey Recorder Class I qualification.
- (2) Candidates possessing Survey Recorder Class II qualification must have an experience of not less than 6 years in Hydrographic Survey from the date of acquiring the Survey Recorder Class II qualification.

Explanation – I

Recognized Hydrographic Survey service for the purpose of these rules may include the following:

1. Service in the Hydrographic Department of the Indian Navy.
2. Service in the Hoogly River Survey Service.
3. Service in the Hydrographic Survey Wing of the Kerala State Port Department.
4. Service in the Hydrographic Survey wing of the Ministry of Transport of the Government of India.
5. Service in the Hydrographic Organization of the Maritime states of India.
6. Service in the Hydrographic Survey Department of the Major Ports of India.

Explanation -II

Experience is the number of years of experience after acquiring the basic Academic qualification.

8. **Mode of Sending applications:**

Applications, with a Photo uploaded, shall be submitted online only. Photo shall be taken within six months. Candidates name and date of Photograph taken shall be printed at the bottom. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz., www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents

to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Application which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

9. Last date for receipt of applications: 30/11/ 2011 Wednesday upto 12.00 midnight

11.If a written Test/OMR Test is conducted as part of the Selection, Hall Ticket of eligible Candidates will be made available in the website of the Kerala public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Hall Ticket as per the instructions in the website.

12.At the time of Examination, Physical Efficiency Test, Practical Test, Interview etc Candidates shall produce their Photo affixed ID proof in Original and self attested photocopy of any one of the following documents (Voters Identity Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare Department to Physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed Pass Books issued by Nationalized Banks, PAN Card, Identity Cards issued to Government Employees by the concerned Departments) along with Hall Tickets.
